Our Safety Measures

- Exterior doors remain locked and are unlocked via buzzer/intercom/video system.
- Two-way radios facilitate communication between staff members at Kingsbury High/Middle School and Kingsbury CTC.
- KCTC's school-wide discipline plan is enforced daily.
- Random metal detector checks screen all students on a regular basis.
- A security committee meets four times a year to discuss safety issues, strategies, and policies changes.
- Sixteen security cameras, located throughout the shop areas, hallways, and parking lots, monitor and record 24 hours a day.

- **District:** The “*School Matters*” newsletter is distributed to parents each six-weeks.
