

## 2010 MIDDLE SCHOOL FOOTBALL SCHEDULE

All games will start at 4:00 unless otherwise indicated.

Designated home teams are listed last, and will sit on **PRESSBOX SIDE OF THE STADIUM.**

**EXCEPTION:** Schools playing games on their campus will ALWAYS sit on the press box side of the field and home team designation will only apply to color of jersey. Home school will wear dark jerseys.

**TEAMS WILL WARM-UP TO THE RIGHT OF THE FIFTY-YARD LINE AS THEY FACE THE FIELD**

The home team is responsible for the clock and announcer during the regular season and play-off games.

**THE HOME TEAM OF EACH CONTEST MUST SUBMIT THE OUTCOME OF THAT GAME TO THE MIAA VIA E-MAIL ([perryjl@mcsk12.net](mailto:perryjl@mcsk12.net)) AFTER EACH FOOTBALL GAME PLAYED BY 12:00 NOON THE FOLLOWING DAY**

### **New TSSAA Heat Policy**

No activities will be allowed when the heat index at the location of the activity is in excess of 104 degrees. This includes practice and contests at any level (HS, MS, JV, etc...) and at any location (indoor or outdoor). Schools are required to measure the heat index at the location of its activities associated with sanctioned sports. Schools will need to have the capability to measure the heat index at the site(s) where activities take place. It is the home team's responsibility to measure heat index when needed before athletic contests to determine what adjustments, if any, need to be made.

### **Suggested Ticket Price**

\$3.00 – at the gate during regular season games and play-offs; HOWEVER, City Championship and homecoming tickets will be \$5.00. Pre-sold tickets will be honored at the gate, but must be identified by each school's designated representative before entry is allowed.

TO SHARE THE GATE RECEIPTS EACH SCHOOL MUST HAVE SOMEONE WORKING THE GATE AT THE START OF THE GAME. THE HOME SCHOOL SHOULD BRING THE TICKETS TO BE SOLD AT THE GATE. HOWEVER, THE PARTICIPATING SCHOOL'S ADMINISTRATOR OR THEIR DESIGNEE MUST IDENTIFY ALL PRE-SOLD TICKETS UPON ENTRY TO THE CONTEST. RECEIPTS COLLECTED AT THE GATE SHOULD BE TAKEN TO THE HOME SCHOOL AND DEPOSITED. A CHECK SHOULD BE WRITTEN TO THE VISITING SCHOOL SPLITTING THE GATE RECEIPTS.

- Weight 12 to 14 ounces
- Long Circumference 26 to 27 inches
- Long Axis 10 to 11 inches
- Short Circumference 19 to 20 inches
- Inflation pressure 12/12 to 13/12 pounds

### **Officials**

The referee assigned to a game will call the home team school by 12:00 p.m. (noon) on the day of the game. The home school will be responsible for paying the officials the day of the game. The MIAA office will reimburse the home schools at the end of the season (\$60.00 per official x 3 officials).

Coaches should call the MIAA office (901. 416.7470) and/or Don Williams (901.415.3084) immediately and leave a message in the event that there are not enough officials to start a football game. Also, notify the MIAA office if no officials are present, or if officials are late. For play-off, purposes four officials will be assigned to each game.

**Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)**

The EMT assigned to a game will call the home team school by 12:00 p.m. (noon) on the day of the game. The home school will be responsible for paying the EMT the day of the game. The MIAA office will reimburse the home schools at the end of the season (\$50.00).

**Coaches should call the Certified Athletic Trainer that is assigned to your area and/or Lou Stackley (901. 488.8490) immediately in the event that there is no EMT to start a football game or if the EMT is late.**

**City Championship**

A meeting will be held Friday, October 8, 2010, 4:00 p.m. at the MIAA office to determine how teams will be seeded in the City Championship. A coach or a representative must be present with their athletic record at the time seeding is done. If a representative is not present, the following will occur:

- a) Removal of the coach for the City Championship series and the coach will not be allowed to attend the play-offs and/or City Championship game.
- b) A school that does not attend the City Championship meeting must pay a \$250.00 fine to be included. The fine will be payable before participation in Tournament play and will be awarded to any school that is removed from the tournament. Exception for Track & Field only: The teams will be allowed to participate as open lanes permit.

### MIAA CONSTITUTION & BY-LAW TIE BREAKER PROCEDURE:

#### 103. City Championship

##### 103.2 Tie Breaker Procedure

- a. Head-to-Head competition in league play. If teams have played each other during the season, the outcome of these games will resolve the tie.
- b. If a tie remains after (a), the tie breaker will be determined by how teams have done against the next highest seeded teams in their respected league: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, etc.
- c. If the tie remains after (a) and (b), the overall win-loss record against teams Within that classification will be used to break the tie. This only includes games played in your classification with member schools of TSSAA.
- d. If the tie remains after (a), (b), and (c), the best overall record will be used to the tie. The best overall record includes games and tournaments with all teams associated with the National Federation of State High School Association (**NFHS**). Scheduled games must be on a Official MIAA Schedule to count for the championship purposes.
- e. If a tie remains, a coin will be tossed. A draw will be used to determined who call the coin toss. The number system will be used to determine who calls the coin.
