ATHLETIC DIRECTOR CHECKLIST

MIAA Athletic Health Services requires the following items for each athletic program prior to each season.

- Current CPR & First Aid for all faculty and non faculty coaches
- TSSAA Eligibility Report Rosters for each sport applicable
 - Reports faxed/mailed to the MIAA Office
 - Insurance payments/TSSAA Report Rosters mailed to the MIAA by deadline
- Athlete's Health Record for each Student-Athlete
 - Physicals dated between May-May
 - Physical by FNP, MD or PA
 - Complete medical/contact information
 - Consent for sport(s) participation
 - Parent's Signature
- Football equipment properly kept and reconditioned
 - Proof of reconditioned equipment
- Copies of all documentation kept with the Athletic Director in an orderly manner and secure location

REMEMBER

- Copies of Athlete Health Record kept with the Coach at all games/practices
- Basic first aid kit, injury ice and water at all games/practices
- Share health and safety information with coaches

Athletic programs that can not produce the requested items place the Memphis City Schools' District at greater risk of liability. Students and Coaches who do not meet these eligibility standards set by the MIAA adopted by the APDC are not allowed to participate in MCS athletic programs.
