

## WHO MAY APPLY

Hollis F. Price Middle College accepts students who are entering the 9th grade and accepts a limited number of students who are entering the 10th grade.

Students must enter with a sincere commitment and strong desire to work diligently throughout the school year, during the summer months, and after school hours where mandated.

Any students interested in applying must be in good academic standing, must have acceptable attendance, conduct, and behavioral records, and should possess strong work ethics and study skills.

Transportation will not be provided by the school district. Students are responsible for their transportation. One transportation option is Memphis Public Transit Association (MATA), which provides bus routes directly to the campus of LeMoyne-Owen College.

## HOW TO APPLY

Applications may be requested through the administrative office of Hollis F. Price Middle College. All applications must be submitted along with the following items:

- ◇ 3 Letters of Recommendation (*school administrator, school counselor, and teacher*)
- ◇ Most Recent Report Card
- ◇ 8th grade TCAP or Standardized Test Results
- ◇ Student's Individual Attendance & Discipline Report (*WinSchool if applicable*)

Final copies of report card, attendance, discipline, and behavioral reports will be requested at interview time.

Standardized test results will assist in the development of Differentiated Instructional Methodologies & Data Collection and Analyses.

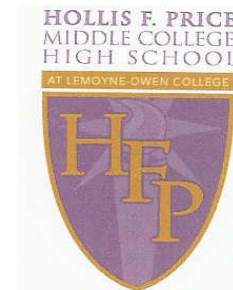

# Hollis F. Price Middle College High School ... *an Early College*

Hollis F. Price Middle College High School is a Memphis City School, located on the historic campus of LeMoyne-Owen College. It is designed under the *Early College High School Initiative* where students earn both a high school diploma and two years of college credit toward a bachelor's degree. Hollis F. Price Middle College also has the distinction and recognition of being the first *Early College* located on a historically black college or university.

Hollis F. Price Middle College is an *Early College* designed for students who may be underrepresented in a traditional setting, but have the academic potential and are willing to accept the challenges of a rigorous high school and college curriculum. Students will have full academic schedules consisting of high school and college courses. It is a "school of opportunity" for students who would like to take advantage of a dual enrollment program in a small nurturing academic environment. Financial and other barriers to college are removed.

Students will be enrolled for five years so that they will successfully earn both the high school diploma and accumulate the sixty hours of college credit. Summer school is included in this program.

It is not an alternative school for disruptive students or a charter school.

## CURRICULUM

All students who are enrolled in Hollis F. Price Middle College will enroll in the traditional Memphis City Schools' courses and will be enrolled in LeMoyne-Owen College's general core curriculum within a five year period.

## SUPPORT SERVICES

There are many student support services provided for students enrolled at Hollis F. Price Middle College to assist them in the transition from middle school to middle college. Students who are enrolled in the college courses will receive additional support as they transition into the college experience. Some of the services that are offered are:

- ◇ Weekly "House" or Teacher Advisory Sessions
- ◇ Daily Academic Counseling
- ◇ Seminars
- ◇ Weekly Tutorials
- ◇ Peer Mediation
- ◇ Peer Counseling
- ◇ College Mentoring

- ◇ LOC "Bridge" Program

## EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

All students enrolled at Hollis F. Price Middle College are able to participate in many of the approved and available high school and college organizations and activities. Students who participate must abide by the district and college guidelines specifically designed for each particular organization. Students engage in organized interaction with the college students and are guided by sanctions that support each organization.

Some of the LeMoyne-Owen College organizations available are: Gospel Choir, LeMoyne-Owen College Newsmagazine, Drama Club, Poetry Club, Cheerleader, and Jazz Ensemble.

Many of the traditional high school organizations are also available.

As an *Early College* associated with the Middle College National Consortium, many students will also attend the Annual Middle College High School National Student Leadership Conference, held in various cities throughout the country.
