### Member Selection Process

The selection procedure is determined by the local Faculty Council, approved by the principal, and is published and available for review by students, faculty, and parents.

The selection of members to this chapter is by a majority vote of the Faculty Council consisting of five faculty members appointed by the principal. The chapter adviser is the sixth, non-voting, ex-officio member of the Faculty Council.

Prior to selection, the following will occur:

- a. Students' academic records will be reviewed to determine scholastic eligibility. Scholastically eligible students are those who meet the required cumulative GPA standard of 3.5.
- b. Students who are eligible scholastically (candidates) will be notified and asked to submit the Student Activity Information Form detailing the candidate's accomplishments in the areas of Service and Leadership for further consideration for selection.
- c. The entire faculty will evaluate all candidates.
- d. The Faculty Council will review the Student Activity Information Form and faculty evaluations in order to determine membership.
- e. Candidates become members when inducted at a special ceremony.

The selection of new members will be held once a year. Students are eligible for membership after the completion of the tenth grade year.

### Discipline and Dismissal

Any member who falls below the standards of scholarship, leadership, character, or service may be dismissed from the Hollis F. Price Middle College High School Chapter of the National Honor Society. A member of the National Honor Society is expected to maintain his/her academic standing and take an active role in service and leadership to his/her school and community.

If a member's cumulative grade point average falls below the standard in effect when he/she was selected (3.5), he/she will be given a warning and a time period for improvement before being subjected to further disciplinary action by the Faculty Council that may include dismissal from the chapter. Violation of the law, school regulations, or the school conduct code can result in the dismissal of a member.
