## COLLEGE TRANSITION TIPS

- *Review your 4-year plan and obtain the required units for graduation.*
- *Take the appropriate Gateway Tests.*
- *Strive to maintain a good grade point average.*
- *Begin to explore information for college entrance. Start a college file.*
- *Make a list of your interests, educational goals, talents and personal qualities. Discuss these with your counselor.*
- *Start making a list of your high school activities and list your involvement in activities outside of the school.*
- *Take the ACT or SAT. (Do the Writing Assessment Tests if your college of choice requires it.)*
- *Check deadlines for admissions applications and scholarship competitions.*
- *Identify teachers, administrators, counselors and other adults whom you can ask for a letter of recommendation.*
- *Attend ACT and SAT prep sessions to become test wise.*
- *Attend financial aid workshops in your school and community.*
- *Complete financial aid applications, and mail them as soon after January 1 as possible.*
- *Narrow and rank your college choices.*
- *Notify the college of the choice that you plan to attend.*

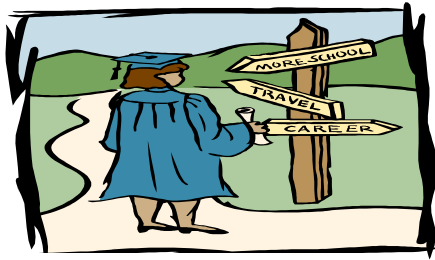

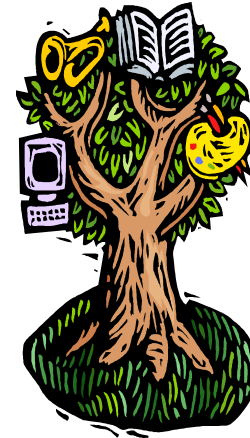

- Allow your child time to read.
- Start early preparing for life after high school. (Discuss future goals with your child and devise ways to achieve those goals.)
